Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Can I drive my child to camp late or pick them up early. No. If children can not make the entire week for any reason, we ask them to stay back and attend scheduled classes.
- 2. If kids stay back do they have to come to school. If they go to camp, do they have to catch up on work missed during the week? Yes. They will have regularly scheduled classes. No. There will be academic components at camp and back at school.
- 3. What time do we need to arrive on Oct. 21st? Students need to arrive at 5:50 a.m. They can go directly to the ASF pick up/drop off zone. Medication can be dropped off at the medical table located at the doors to the WEC.

- 4. Can I have someone else drop my children off? Yes, someone can drop your kids off but we recommend you do it.
- 5. What time can I pick my child up on Friday? We will arrive to ASF by 3:30 on Wednesday, Oct. 23. **You** can pick your kids up when the bus arrives.
- 6. Can my son/daughter bring a cell phone? All cell phones will be taken when we arrive to Puebla. Phones that are found during camp will be given to the MS office and parents will be asked to come pick them up.
- 7. What is the ratio of adults to kids. Last year it was about 7:1
