















Social & Emotional Wellbeing

TEMPERATURE CHECK

- + We will take the temperature of the students prior to getting on the bus. If the temperature is greater than 38, they will be sent to a secondary table. If it is still 38, they will not be permitted to board the bus.
- + If at any time at camp, their temperature reaches 38 degrees, we will ask that they are picked up.

INFLUENZA VACCINE

The influenza vaccine is usually available from September on. If you are interested in vaccinating your children, be on the look for it then.

SPENDING MONEY

The children do not need money, but they might like to bring a little bit to buy a souvenir. We suggest 200-300 pesos. Students are responsible for their money.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Can I drive my child to camp late or pick them up early. No. If children can not make the entire week for any reason, they must stay back and attend the scheduled classes.
- 2. If kids stay back do they have to come to school. If they go to camp, do they have to catch up on work missed during the week? Yes. They will have regularly scheduled classes. No. they do not have to catch up on missed work.
