



- YOUR CHILD MUST HAVE VALID PASSPORT (An expired passport is not valid)
- YOUR CHILD MUST HAVE DATES OF TRAVEL AND AIRLINE FLIGHT NUMBER
 - APPLY ONLINE AT
www.canada.ca
 - SEARCH ***“How to apply for an ETA”***
- CLICK AT THE BOTTOM OF THE ETA INFO PAGE THE **BLUE** BUTTON **APPLY**
(You can also change the language to Spanish as your default language)
 - ANSWER THE QUESTIONS AND PAY THE FEE

You will have your child’s ETA within 24 hours attached to the passport number

- ALTHOUGH YOUR CHILD WILL TRAVEL WITH SCHOOL CHAPERONES WITH THE GROUP, THE PROCESS IS A **MUCH** MORE COMPLICATED TO NAME THEM IN YOUR APPLICATION (The listed chaperone would have to meet each child and family at the immigration office individually)
 - GIVE A COPY OF YOUR APPROVED SAM FORM TO YOUR CHAPERONE AND BRING AN EXTRA COPY ON THE DAY OF TRAVEL
